He freely bestowed His grace upon us in the Beloved. (Jesus) (Ephesians 1:6)

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses. (Ephesians 1:8)

In Him the Father purposed to make known to us the mystery of His will. (Ephesians 1:9)

In Him we have obtained an inheritance. (Ephesians 1:11)

You were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise. (Ephesians 1:13)

God made us alive with Christ, and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places, in Christ Jesus, in order that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:4-7)
