Dear friends,

Jackie and I again say hello in the Wonderful Name of Jesus! Your friendship means much to us, and we wish we could see you in person and talk to each of you often. We are grateful to be able to send this letter to you.

If you read our last letter, you know we have scheduled a **trip to Ukraine**. Jackie and I are going for the purpose of ministering to churches in three cities -- Krivoy Rog where we went one year ago to plant a new church, and also two other Ukrainian cities, Gorlovka and Kherson. Two more charismatic churches have been started in Krivoy Rog since we were there. We want to pour in the teaching of the Word of God to these young churches: they need to be established on good foundations. We will have two weeks among the three new churches in Krivoy Rog, and two weeks of ministry in young churches in two other cities: Gorlovka and Kherson. **It will be four solid weeks, every day teaching the Word and ministering to people by the Holy Spirit.** Please pray for grace, wisdom, strength, and the anointing of the Spirit. The lives of the Ukrainian believers are much more difficult than here in comfortable Minnesota. They are hungry for God in the midst of a chaotic land where just putting bread on the table is a great struggle. The report is that it may be even worse for them in the days ahead, and the doors may not stay open to help them. We believe the Lord is leading us to give ourselves *now* to feed them the Word of God. **Will you help send us?**

The dates for our Ukrainian ministry are November 14 through December 15. We are ready give ourselves and our time, but the Lord must lead our friends to give the finances to make it happen. Our air tickets are to be paid on November 7. Expense money while in Ukraine is also needed before we leave on November 14. We hope to also bring a financial blessing with us for the church to use in the spreading of the gospel. As of this writing, all is still needed!

Will you help us get there? Please pray for our journey and for the release of the funds, and then...just do what He tells you to do.

Please also pray for our monthly support. We have a large financial need which must be taken care of before we leave for Ukraine....will you stand with us for this personal need as well as for what is needed for the ministry outreach?


You will notice that **the time is very short** -- we are to leave three weeks from the date of this letter! Praise the Lord! He is able to do it quickly.
