...a prayer letter from John and Jackie

January 5, 1998



Dear friends,

This is a special reminder letter, sent to ask you to pray for our three upcoming schools of prayer. It is of great concern to us that we have others praying for us as we step out to lead and teach others in the midst of our own sense of inadequacy. Hence this reminder:

1. **"I WILL NOT LET YOU GO UNTIL YOU BLESS ME!"** Starting January 13, Tuesday evenings at 7, Church Upon The Rock.

The purpose of the school is to encourage *"fervent, unceasing, persevering, prevailing"* prayer. A tall order, don't you think? We desperately need the presence and power of the Spirit in this school, or it all will come to little or nothing. There has been considerable interest shown in this school, and we definitely feel the need for more spiritual support. **Will you pray for us and for all who will attend?** If you can, join us. Your presence will be a great encouragement, and as we pray together, we can help others learn to yield to the spirit of prayer.

Remember, This school has no tuition or registration, and is open to anyone.

2. **"Jesus Christ, Chief Intercessor"**. January 27 - March 24, Tuesday mornings at 10:10, Heart for the Nations at Church of the Resurrection.

We plan to spend much time in the Word, laying the foundation of our complete and certain redemption in Jesus Christ, a foundation necessary for bold praying. Please pray that many new and seasoned prayer warriors will take the time for this specially focused school of prayer. We'd love to have you there, of course. \$65.00 tuition.

3. **School of Prayer and Spiritual Warfare**, starting January 21, Wednesday and Thursday evenings, at the Salvation Army, East St. Paul.

This school is meant only for the leaders and members of this Salvation Army church, to equip them for reaching out in their own community. Though we are not inviting you to this school, please pray that our input will be helpful to them, and that God will use this church to bring healing and deliverance to many of the troubled families in that area.

For all three schools, pray:

1. That we will be yielded to the Holy Spirit, and follow His leading.
2. That the Lord's presence will be strong.
3. That the Lord will bring together people who are hungry for Him.
4. That the spirit and burden of prayer and intercession will come on us all.
5. That the living Word of God will be taught clearly.
6. That we and those attending would experience a refreshing and refilling of the Holy Spirit.

Thanks for standing with us in prayer during these three months when these schools will be in session.
