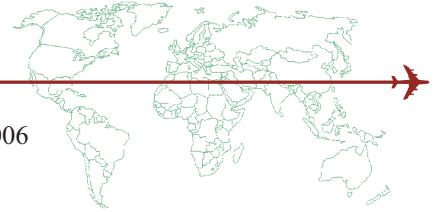




Lifeline

...a prayer letter from John and Jackie

Dear friends,

We greet you once again in the wonderful name of Jesus!

This is a brief letter to remind you to pray for us, as John leaves today, Oct. 25.

John's schedule is as follows:

October 27: Arrive in Yerevan, Armenia

John will be preaching every day in various Churches of Praise in different parts of Armenia, and meet with all the leaders. Please pray for the presence and anointing of the Holy Spirit, and for the Word to go forth clearly into the minds and hearts of the believers.

Pray also for the planning that will go on regarding the new mission from Armenia into a Muslim country that is much in our news these days.

Monday, November 6: Leave Armenia and arrive in Krivoy Rog, Ukraine

John will have a full schedule of teaching in the Bible and Mission Colleges, the pastors conference, and meetings with senior leaders. There is much to do in a short time. Pray for the teaching of the Word to be bold and to bring understanding, and for all communication to be clear.

Pray especially for a new ministry beginning in one of the "stan" countries to the east. We are in the first stages of launching a mission there with a family from Tajikistan who have been working in this country for five years doing charitable aid with a Christian ministry. They are planning to open churches there in association with Churches of Praise. This missionary is in his mid thirties, a former Muslim, with Christian wife and four children.

Wednesday, November 22: Arrive back in Minneapolis
