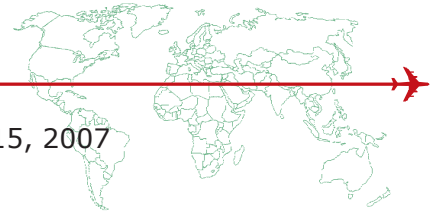


Lifeline

...a prayer letter from John and Jackie

Dear friends,

Greetings again in the Name of Jesus! It is a privilege to write to you, and we both are honored by your friendship and support.

Ministry in Ukraine and Armenia...

Ministry while travelling during October was almost entirely teaching the blood covenant. I did this in six training schools within the Churches of Praise – four schools in Ukraine and two in Armenia. In Ukraine, I taught all morning as well as in the evening. In Armenia, the schools met in the afternoon and evening. So on most days, I taught for three or four hours, laying the foundations of our blood-bought salvation in Jesus Christ. From Genesis to revelation, we followed the "scarlet thread" of the blood of Jesus through the Bible.

Thank God for the blood of Jesus, and the written covenant of the Bible sealed in that blood! We are grateful for the gospel which opens up the power of heaven to all who hear -- who understand, receive, believe and walk in it!

The gospel *is* His power, according to Romans 1:16, where Paul said, "I am not ashamed of the gospel, for **it is the power of God** for salvation to everyone who believes..."

The gospel must be preached. It must be taught thoroughly, making sure to include ALL that God has abundantly provided in Jesus Christ.

By God's grace, we will keep preaching this Wonderful News near and far. May this Message reach all the nations ...and hasten the return of the Lord!

Writing a book...

I could spend the rest of my life teaching this personally, but it is not possible to teach the blood covenant in person to everyone in our sphere of influence. So, it is time to complete an unfinished project. Jackie and I hope to finish writing the blood covenant book during the winter months. I am the writer; she is the editor and source of wisdom on how to do it. We want it translated into the four languages in which we presently work - Ukrainian, Russian, Armenian, and Farsi. After teaching through interpreters for so many years, it will be a dream fulfilled to know that people can read our teaching in their own language!

We especially want to get this message to the villages of the world -- the poor and neglected who do not understand the entire story of their great salvation in Jesus. In remote areas where a book is treasured it is read over and over by more than one person. We believe this book will help all believers experience more fully their new life in Christ.

Please agree with us in prayer for the writing of the

blood covenant teaching. It needs to be written under the same anointing the Lord gives when it is taught in person. Once that is accomplished, anointed translators will be needed who can write as well as speak. Please pray for the yet unknown translators to come to us soon!

Churches of Praise are still on the move...

In the main church in Krivoy Rog, where I spent most of my time, there were many people being saved in the regular meetings. Twelve to twenty came for repentance on Sunday mornings, and several more in each evening meeting. Testimonies of healings and miracles were given regularly.

There are Churches of Praise in ten prisons. Sasha and Tanya, directors of the prison ministry, reported that, in the last three months, they had baptized one hundred and twelve. It was awesome to watch on DVD prisoner after prisoner come up out of that water in the barrel with the joy of their salvation!

In Armenia the Churches of Praise are small. However, there is also a fresh harvest, especially in Yerevan the capital city. During each week of this past month, several people have been saved.

Our partners in Afghanistan called to report that they had recently prayed for a Muslim man who had been sent home by doctors to die with inoperable cancer. He was rapidly getting better, and he, his wife, and all six children have been saved!

It is a great joy to be involved where God is at work!

Financial update...

\$7000 for continuing church planting work has been provided for November and December. Praise the Lord! Agree with us in faith that it will continue in January, February, March and beyond.

Gregory and I discussed with Churches of Praise leaders that it appeared the support was ending. After time with these leaders, it was clear to me that God was not saying to stop or slow down the ministry. He was instead saying to do more! Somehow He will provide for His work.
